LEGAL INFORMATION PROJECT for refugees in CHIOS (EU Hotspot in Greece)

Since May 2017, rlc abroad has been working with a small team on the Greek island of Chios, offering legal information to those seeking protection and who are supposed to be deported to Turkey after the EU-Turkey statement took into effect. The focus of our work lies on the preparation for and accompaniment to asylum interviews and support in family reunion procedures under the Dublin III Regulation.

As from September 2018, we will work exclusively with long-term volunteers who stay on Chios for at least 3 months and e.g. complete the legal clerkship or an internship with us.

Requirements

- Lawyer, law student, legal clerk or asylum procedure advisor
- Sound knowledge of national, European and international asylum law
- Alternatively: very good knowledge of Greek
- Experience in legal advice / legal information
- (Working) experience abroad
- Very good knowledge of English
- High resilience and ability to cope with a high workload
- Possibility of self-financing the assignment (e.g. legal clerkship, scholarship via Erasmus+ or DAAD, or own funds)

Framework

- At least 3 months stay in Chios
- Financial support for accommodation costs possible if required
- Flight costs have to be paid by the volunteer
- Participation in the **Selection Seminar on 25 and 26 August 2018** in Berlin

Work in Chios

- Providing with information on the asylum procedure and preparation for the asylum interview
- Providing information on possibilities and conditions for family reunion, in particular under the Dublin III Regulation, and legal support in this procedure
- Forwarding cases to Greek and German lawyers including drafting arguments for interim measures concerning Dublin III family reunion before German Courts
- Cooperation with local actors
- Optional: follow-up of the stay, e.g. with publications in order to draw public attention to conditions in the EU Hotspots

What we offer

- A highly dynamic, interesting and challenging working environment, both practically and theoretically
- Pleasant cooperation in a small team of highly motivated lawyers
- Completion of compulsory internships or an internship as part of the legal clerkship in accordance with the requirements of the respective examination regulations or of the respective federal state
